PROGRAM EXCELLENCE

In 2017 **Program Excellence** funds (\$4,400) were used for staff training and continuing education, including sending our leadership team to the American Camp Association National Conference.

SONLIGHT SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The **Sonlight Scholarship Fund** (\$30,105 in 2017) provided financial assistance to **112 campers** and their families, helping make tuition affordable and offering every kid the opportunity of camp.
